## Grand Valley State (Mich.) Takes Top Spot in the Second Fall Division II Learfield Sports Directors' Cup Standings

**Cleveland, Ohio** – After the completion of six NCAA Championships, Grand Valley State (Mich.) has taken the lead in the second installment of the Learfield Sports Directors' Cup fall standings. In the most recent championships, the Lakers placed third in women's volleyball and ninth in women's soccer increasing their point total to 312.

Massachusetts Lowell is in second, trailing Grand Valley by 71 points. The River Hawks have accumulated a total of 241 points after finishing fifth in men's soccer.

Tampa (Fla.) is in a close third with 231 total points, after finishing third in men's soccer, and 17<sup>th</sup> in both women's soccer and women's volleyball.

Rounding out the top-five are Metropolitan State (Colo.) and Slippery Rock (Pa.), who are fourth and fifth respectively. The Roadrunners added 133 points to their previous total of 84 after placing third in women's soccer, 17<sup>th</sup> in men's soccer and 33<sup>rd</sup> in women's volleyball for 217 points.

In fifth and seven points behind Metropolitan State is The Rock of Slippery Rock (Pa.) with 210 points, who finished ninth in men's soccer and 17<sup>th</sup> in both women's soccer and women's volleyball.

Six of the seven fall NCAA championships have been completed with the following institutions capturing titles: Adams State (men's and women's cross country); Bloomsburg (Penn.) (women's field hockey); Seattle Pacific (Wash.) (women's soccer); Cal State Dominguez Hills (men's soccer); and Concordia (Minn.) (women's volleyball).

The Learfield Sports Directors' Cup was developed as a joint effort between the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) and *USA Today*. Points are awarded based on each institution's finish in up to 14 sports -- seven women's and seven men's.

The final Division II standings will be released Tuesday, December 23.
